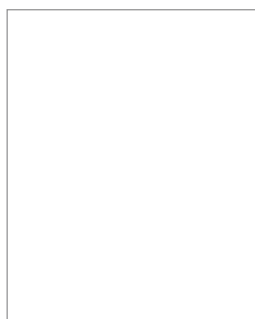

Note :

Except for "Emergencies" before going to the clinic, students must get the necessary entries to be filled in the student organiser by the class/subject teacher and seek permission.

HOSTEL :

- (A) The hostellers should inform their respective teachers before coming to the school clinic for treatment during class hours.
- (B) Hostellers who are sent home with Parents/Local guardians on grounds of illness, have to produce a medical certificate along with a certificate of fitness from the doctor treating them at the time of joining the hostel.



GUIDELINES TO PARENTS/GUARDIANS

An overall performance of the child and his/ her personality and safety depends equally on school and home environment. So in order to do the best for your ward parents/ guardians are also expected to follow the given points so that we together can prepare your child to become a responsible citizen.

1. Parents are requested not to send their wards to the school if they are ill or suffering from any contagious disease.
2. Parents must attend the PTMs on regular basis in order to keep a track on the progress of their ward. This is compulsory.
3. Parents must check the personal hygiene and cleanliness of their child/children. Please see that they wear proper uniform which is clean and neat. child must carry all the necessary things to the school.
4. Please inform the School Office in writing if there is any change in your address/ telephone numbers/office address etc.
5. It is mandatory for every child to attend the school on National festivals & School programmes day.
6. Please send your child to the school every day. Please don't allow a child to remain absent except for health issues or exceptionally valid reasons.
7. Please check your ward's almanac daily and ensure that, the assigned homework is done on time and do countersign the remarks mentioned.
8. Please ensure that the residential and official addresses with phone numbers are correct. This is required to establish efficient communication.
9. Please see that your ward participates in all school activities – sports, games and other co-curricular activities, holistic development.
10. Students cannot be called to the school office to attend the phone calls during school hours. Parents may leave the message at the reception on a call.
11. Parents/Guardians are not permitted to enter classrooms to meet their children or to seek unscheduled meetings with teachers during school hours.
12. Any written communication that parents wish to make with the school should be made on A-4 sheet and must be addressed to the Principal.
E-mail is the most preferred form of communication.



13. Students are advised not to bring valuable articles .School shall not undertake any responsibility for the loss.
14. All students are expected to join the school on the notified date at the beginning of the term.
15. Care must be taken of all school property and if any damage is done, it will be repaired on the student's cost as a fine.
16. Parents must first consult the school calendar, datesheets and other circulars, before making enquiries on the phone.
17. The name, class & section of the pupil should be clearly marked on all belongings of the child. School will not be responsible for the lost materials.
18. The students who habitually keep indulging in cheating, misbehavior or misconduct, despite repeated warning and constant efforts by the staff to improve their behavior, will be expelled even at the time of final Examination. These types of cases will be judged by a Disciplinary Committee, appointed by the Principal.
19. Parents are requested to show complete faith on system & school especially in front of their wards so that the child does not lose faith in teachers, school & its system. This is essential for building strong relationship between the child & school staff. They must avoid using foul language against school's system.
20. Important messages are communicated, well in advance, through the students or through remarks of class teachers in their diary or through SMS. Students will be responsible for any misinterpretation of any rule of keeping the parents in the dark about the remarks given by the authority of the school.
21. If any student is found harming others or self, immediate disciplinary action will be taken.
22. Parents are expected to support the school and school staff in observance of the roles.
23. Any child suffering from any contagious diseases will be sent back to home.
24. **During school hours phone call to the teachers are not allowed.**

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS

- 1) Students must be attentive, punctual, obedient, humble, regular & disciplined in school.
- 2) Punctuality and regularity in attendance is essential. Students who have been absent the previous day must bring a note of explanation through 'Non Attendance & Leave Record' page of the almanac without fail. In case of illness a medical certificate should be sent.
- 3) Students must come to school in neat laundered uniform and polished shoes. The hair should be trimmed and the nails must be cut regularly. Girls with long hair should make plaits. Skirts should be worn knee-length.
- 4) A student must speak in descent language all the time. He must ensure that his speech is courteous and polite.
- 5) Any communication sent in the school almanac must be acknowledged by the parent/guardian.
- 6) English is second language for most of us, but it is also a medium of instruction. In order to acquire proficiency in spoken English, all students must compulsorily converse in English in school (and at home as far as possible).
- 7) A student must extend due courtesy and respect to all members of staff. Respect of elders and affection for juniors should be soundly inculcated. Every child is expected to uphold the name and honour of the school.
- 8) If a student is absent, it is his/her responsibility to complete his/her absence work.
- 9) Students should carry sufficient stationary to avoid awkward situation. At the same time no expensive stationeries should be brought to the school.
- 10) Students must refrain from damaging any form of school property. The school reserves the right to be compensated by the student for any such damage.
- 11) Unacceptable behavior including irregular attendance, academic dishonesty and neglect of H.W., loitering and disrespectful behavior towards staff or fellow students will result in disciplinary action.
- 12) Proper queue must be maintained as and when required. The manner of movement should be quiet and orderly, at all times.
- 13) Any pupil who is persistently insubordinate or is repeatedly or willfully mischievous or is guilty of malpractice in connection with examination has committed an act of serious indiscipline and/or misbehavior may be expelled permanently or removed from the school for a specific period by the Principal.
- 14) Anybody who organizes or takes part in unauthorized activities will be liable for disciplinary action.
- 15) Complete your class work, home work, project work and all the academic work on time as expected.
- 16) Students must not bring & explode explosives/fire crackers at school. If students will be found indulged in such cases will be expelled from the school.
- 17) If any student is found harming others or self, immediate disciplinary action will be taken.
- 18) Long leave for marriages, functions, ceremonies etc will not be granted suddenly or at random. **A maximum of four days leave will be granted to a child in a session** if found necessary. If applied for leave and sanctioned under unavoidable circumstances, the responsibility there after regarding the "**Progress of the child in his/her studies**" is to be that of the child or the parent. Parents should utilize full-scape paper for applying leave.
- 19) Stylish hair cuts are not allowed. The hair cut should be simple matching to the decorum of the school. . The child has to obey the instructions given by the Class Teacher/School. Disciplinary action will be taken if the child doesn't follow the instructions.
- 20) **Beard is not allowed except for Sikh boys.**

PROHIBITED ITEMS

1. Trinket, Jewellery, Henna, or Tattoos
2. Objectionable literature or expensive items.
3. Money, Cell phones, iPods, CD, DVD, e-games, pen drives, cameras, music players, obscene materials etc.
4. Crackers, fireworks, fire arms and any other inflammable material.
5. Gift of any kind for distribution in school even for birthdays.
6. Toys, any dangerous instrument, tobacco products, alcoholic drinks, chewing gum, banned food items.

NOTE : Mobile is restricted, if found penalty of 2000.00 will be charged.

BUS RULES

1. Students are expected to be on their bus stop at least five minutes prior to the arrival of the bus.
2. **Buses will not wait for the latecomers.**
3. Children should always stay away from the main road until the bus arrives.
4. No student should try to board on running bus. They must occupy vacant seats immediately after boarding the buses. The drivers are authorized to stop buses at the designated stop only, unless directed by the transport in charge/Administrator/Teacher in -Charge.
5. The list of stops is prepared keeping in view of the convenience of all and is subject to change.
6. **When the bus is in motion, students must not move around in the bus. They should not keep any part of the body out of the bus.**
7. Students will be held responsible for any damage to bus caused by their negligence or vandalism.
8. No student is allowed to eat or discard trash of food inside and outside the bus.
9. Shrieking, shouting, unruly behavior is strictly prohibited.
10. Courteous behavior is expected always.
11. The driver's attention must not be diverted for any reason.
12. The teachers commuting by bus and the students appointed as bus monitors are responsible for maintaining discipline in buses.
13. Any serious offence must be reported to the ADMINISTRATOR.
14. The students must be in their allocated seats only.
15. The Bus facilities will be withdrawn if any student misbehaves in the school bus in such cases, Parents will be responsible for arranging the conveyance on their own.
16. **GPS & Cameras are installed in all the buses..**

LEAVE/ ABSENCE

1. Students who have been sick for more than five days have to bring a medical certificate from their doctor on the day of rejoining day. A copy of certificate duly signed by the doctor must be submitted in the School Clinic for the follow-up:

Any student returning to school after suffering from any contagious disease will have to produce the doctor's fitness certificate.

- Chickenpox: Till the scabs fall completely
 - Cholera Till the child is completely well.
 - Measles: One week after the rashes disappear.
 - Mumps Until the swelling has subsided.
 - Whooping Cough: Six weeks
2. All the students have to attend the school on the last working day before the vacation and on the reopening day after the vacation. Medical reasons will be entertained on very serious grounds like fracture or other serious illness.
 3. It is compulsory for all the students to be present on the National festival days and the days of school functions. If absent disciplinary action will be taken.
 4. Any student who remains absent from school for three or more successive days without prior information or leave granted their parents will be called.
 5. It is compulsory for all the students to maintain 80% attendance during the course of the academic session to enable them to appear for the final examination. The percentage, however, could be relaxed on medical grounds by 10% at the most.
 6. A special certificate will be given to the students having full attendance.
 7. Leave with or without intimation/application will be considered as absent in all cases.
 8. Half day leave are not given. Please don't apply for half day leave.
In case of any planned reason, please take full day leave on that particular day.
 9. Hosteller parents should drop off their children at school before 6 PM on outing or reporting days.

Penalty will be charged against those students, who remain absent on the last working day before vacation/on reopening day after vacation/on the days of School Function/National Festivals (like 15th August, 26th January).

DISCIPLINARY PROCEDURE

The following disciplinary measures will be adopted by the school:

1. Oral warning and counseling.
2. Written warning/Intimating Parents
3. Suspension
4. Termination / Expulsion

The Principal/School Management retains the right to suspend or expel a student outright if the offence is of a very serious nature.



UNIFORM CODE

Wearing a uniform is a badge of pride, creates an identity for a school and is an important part of being a school student. Uniform gives students a sense of belonging to a particular school and create an identity for the school in the community. A school uniform teaches students to dress smartly and take pride in their appearance.

1. All students must wear only the prescribed uniform on all weekdays without making any alterations. Any alteration, if done without the permission will lead to disciplinary action.
2. Coloured dress is allowed only on birthday and when announced by the school.
3. Children's nails should be check regularly. Their hair should be cut according to school guidelines, and boys should trim theirs beards properly.
4. Tattoos, bangles, goggles, fancy pins etc are strictly not allowed to be worn in school.
5. No expensive accessories should be worn in school.
6. The Identity card and school uniform will be worn everyday and for all School Functions and activities.
7. Every year students have to get complete range of new uniform.
8. Vests should be worn compulsorily under the shirts.
9. Girls must wear cycling shorts (black/navy blue) under the skirt every day.
10. Girls having long hairs must tie their hairs in two plaits and no single pony is allowed in school.
11. Colouring of hair is not allowed in school.
12. All boys must keep their hair short, and should avoid making designs. No stylish hair cuts are allowed Beard are not permitted at all.
